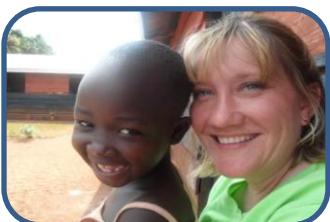
## Sports Festival

## Uganda 2012 Itinerary

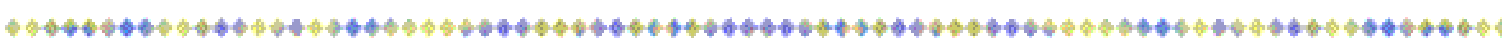
